Producing Fruit with Repentance

(Matt. 3:8)

Fruit is always visible, and repentance will show up as a visible change in what we say and do. As the crowd listened to John's message, they were moved by what they heard and wanted to know what they should do.

Apparently, there were two types of people in the crowd. One that was hungry to hear the message and another group that came to see what was happening but didn't feel the need to be forgiven. They seemed to be clinging to their forefathers' faith and were deceiving themselves by being stiff-necked. Unfortunately, relying on heritage without the need to be forgiven can lead to spiritual disaster.

Mukti has been praying for many years for a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit as it was in 1905 when 70 residents gathered together to pray earnestly for the Lord to revisit and refresh His people. These women who took the initiative to lead the prayer gathering didn't have any proud heritage, to use the language of the Pharisees. They had faced oppression and rejection in their past life and coming to Mukti gave them a sense of dignity and deliverance. In the simplicity of their hearts, they cried to the Lord and the first and foremost act that was evident among them was repentance.

Repentance is not an intention to lead a new life in the future; it begins now, as we step out in obedience in our immediate situation. Many Christians see repentance as an initial act that is completed at the beginning of the Christian life – a kind of gateway to pass through. Yes, the Lord loves when a person immediately feels the need to repent but it's also ongoing. We cannot live on the past glory. As a great theologian said, "God is gracious; He shows us our sins slowly. If He showed them to us all at once, we would be devastated."

As we come to know God more deeply, we will discover more about ourselves and repentance will become deeper, touching areas that we had not known before or kept them hidden for years. As God shows us our sins one by one, let us yield to Him, inclining our ears to listen to what He has to say to us. It is only in repentance that we can bear fruit for Him, fruit that will last.
