## **Open Doors: Betsy Kolkea**



Christian men often lose their jobs, face abuse, and can be kicked out of their homes. Christian women face sexual violence from their own families and communities, and are unlikely to find any justice in the legal system. Islamic militant and criminal groups kidnap and sometimes kill Christians. Those Christians who try to

escape to Europe are targeted in migration camps for human trafficking, forced labour, and sexual enslavement. This is what it means to be a Christian in Libya today, where less that 0.5% of the population are Christians in a militant Islamic state. **Let's stand** with our Christian brothers and sisters in Libya as they follow God at such great risk to themselves. **Let's cover them with our prayers** and ask that they will not feel alone and abandoned even when fellowship with other Christians is so rare. May they know God's special anointing, his presence in whatever form they need it each day, and may they keep their eyes fixed on Him - the author and perfecter of their faith. (Heb. 12).
