Open Doors: Betsy Kolkea



There is a place where children under 18 are forbidden from attending church and where churches have to register with the state or be forcibly closed. If registered, there are restrictions on what can be preached, and political propaganda must be displayed. In this place, any Christians found to be meeting outside of these registered churches face questioning by the authorities and many leaders are imprisoned. This place is China, where almost 100 million Christians live, making up under 7% of the population.

What is the result? Open Doors provides these testimonies: "I was handcuffed and paraded through the streets. All this did not affect my faith in Christ, and after more than 20 years, up to this day, I am still holding on to my faith in Jesus." An Open Doors Partner reveals "Every morning at 4am or 5am, they gather in secret, raising their hands to pray."

Will we allow ourselves to be challenged by their faith in suffering, and **join in praying** for all Christians facing persecution in China today?
